



Swedish-Singapore Scholarship

Are you a hands-on person, with a broad skill-set who is curious about business in Southeast Asia? The Foundation for Swedish Youth Abroad and the Swedish Chamber of Commerce Singapore - SwedCham seeks a new scholar and intern for the fall of 2019.

The scholarship will finance a 6-month internship starting at the end of August 2019 until mid-January 2020, with an option to extend the assignment for another 6 months. The intern will have the opportunity to gain knowledge about the Swedish - Singaporean business community, SwedCham's network, and get insights into the ASEAN-markets and business realities. The Scholar will play an active role in SwedCham's work on both a strategic and operational level.

SwedCham is currently under rapid development; therefore, it is important that you are an active person with many ideas as well as a strong capability to get things done.

The work span includes coordinating events, working with communication, project management of print productions, membership service and administrative tasks. You will also gain strategic insights from participating at SwedCham's Board Committee Meetings.

The scholarship is in the amount of SEK 95 000 which is intended to be used by the scholar to cover for housing and basic living expenses in Singapore, medical and accident insurance, the visa fee and flight tickets.

Qualifications

- You should preferably be in your third Bachelor Degree year or at Master Degree level.
- Have a proven record of project management
- Business-related work experience
- Strong written and verbal communication skills in English
- You do not need prior experience from Southeast Asia, however a successful candidate will be able to show a deep interest in the region.

- A personal letter (max. one page, in English) explaining why you should become SwedCham's next intern
- Your CV (max one page, in English)
- Grade transcripts
